Holy Land Pilgrimage

Nov. 6 & 7, 2018 – USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the **USA** on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the **Holy Land** by our airport representative and transferred to your **Jerusalem** hotel. Enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.

Nov. 8, 2018 – Bethlehem, Ein Karem & Yad Vashem

We begin our journey with a visit to the birthplace of Christ. In **Bethlehem**, **Celebrate Mass in the Shepherds' Fields**. Above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth, visit the Church of the Nativity, built by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century. Also tour the **Manger, Grotto of St. Jerome, Church of St. Catherine, the Crèche and Milk Grotto**. Next, travel to **Ein Karem**, the village where John the Baptist was born and the Virgin Mary visited Elizabeth prior to our Lord's birth (Luke 1:26-40). Visit the **Church of St. John**, birthplace of John the Baptist. End your day with a visit to **Yad Vashem**, Israel's Holocaust Museum, and be touched by the poignant images. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nov. 9, 2018 – Jerusalem

Be inspired, this morning, by the breathtaking beauty of Jerusalem ("the Golden City") as you stand on the **Mount of Olives**. It was from here that Jesus ascended into heaven forty days after His resurrection (Acts 1:9-12). Visit the **Church of Pater Noster** and **Celebrate Mass in the Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus prayed before His crucifixion (Matt. 26:36-44). On **Mount Zion**, see the **House of the High Priest Caiaphas**, where Jesus was imprisoned the night of His arrest (Matt. 26:57-65). Nearby is the **Upper Room** revered as the location of the Last Supper (Mark 14:12-26). View the site of **King David's Tomb**. Conclude your day with a visit to the **Church of the Dormition of Mary**.

Nov. 10, 2018 – Jericho, Wadi Qelt, Qumran & Dead Sea

Journey to **Jericho** (considered the oldest city in the world) to visit the ruins of the ancient city conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6:1). In the distance see the traditional site of the **Temptation of Jesus** (Matt. 4:1). **Celebrate Mass in the Church of the Good Shepherd** in Jericho near a sycamore tree and remember Zacchaeus who climbed to see Jesus (Luke 18-19). Just off the Roman road that Jesus once "walked", see the **Wadi Qelt gorge**, site of the **Monastery of St. George**. Travel to **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947. End your day with the opportunity to take a dip in the mineral laden waters of the **Dead Sea**.

Nov. 11, 2018 – Jerusalem, the Old City

Take time to pray at the **Western Wall**, all that remains of Herod's Temple. Sit on the **Teaching Steps** where Jesus once taught. Take a leisurely stroll down the **Cardo**, the main street of the Old City where modern shops stand between ancient ones. View the **Pool of Bethesda**, where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle of healing (John 5:1-31), and sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne**, renowned for its beautiful acoustics. At **Herod's Antonia Fortress**, see where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1-11). Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross," and **Celebrate the Mass of the Resurrection at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre**.

Nov. 12, 2018 – Mount Tabor & Emmaus

In **Emmaus**, you'll see the traditional site where Jesus appeared to two disciples after His resurrection. Continue to **Mount Tabor** and contemplate what it must have been like for Saints Peter, James and John to behold the glory of the Transfigured Christ (Matt. 17:2). **Celebrate Mass at Mt. Tabor**.

Nov. 13, 2018 – The Galilee

Enjoy beautiful **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry, and visit the synagogue located on the site where Jesus taught (Matt. 4:13, 23). Sail across the **Sea of Galilee** and experience a special on-board worship service. Listen to Jesus's words from His Sermon on the **Mount at the Mount of Beatitudes** (Matt. 5-7) and **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Beatitudes**. At **Tabgha**, traditional location of the feeding of the 5,000, explore the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10). Take a moment to reflect and pray in the **Chapel of the Primacy**, where Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21).

Nov. 14, 2018 – Magdala, Cana, Nazareth & the Jordan River

Following breakfast, visit **Magdala**, once home to Mary Magdalene, and visit a recently discovered first century synagogue. Continue to **Cana of Galilee**, where Our Lord performed His first miracle – changing water into wine at a wedding feast. Here, we'll invite couples to renew their marriage vows. Continue to **Nazareth**, Jesus' Boyhood Home. Following **Mass in Nazareth at the Basilica of the Annunciation**, visit the Cave of the Annunciation. Visit the **Yardenit Baptismal site** at the **Jordan River** and celebrate a remembrance of your baptism.


Nov. 15, 2018 – Mt. Carmel, Caesarea, Haifa & Tel Aviv

Ascend **Mt. Carmel**, home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha and **Celebrate Mass at Stella Maris**. In **Haifa**, visit the **Bahai Gardens**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue down the Mediterranean coast to **Caesarea**, capital of the ancient Roman Procurators of Judea where St. Peter preached and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Visit the **Roman Theater, Crusader's Moat**, and the **Byzantine Churches**. Continue south to **Tel Aviv** and enjoy a light meal before transferring to the airport for your overnight Flight home.

Nov. 16, 2018 – Arrive in Newark, NJ

Return home with a greater understanding of the life and land of our Lord and memories to last a lifetime!
