Candidates are expected to make the time dedicated to Religious Formation classes, activities, prayer, projects and field trips a positive experience for themselves and others.

All Candidates will:

- Be on time and prepared for class
- Follow arrival and dismissal procedures given by the Catechist, Hall Monitors, and Building Coordinators
- Show respect for themselves, Catechists, other students and program personnel
- Be courteous and considerate of others
- Use language and actions expressive of Christian behavior
 Absolutely no cursing or crude gestures
- Obey safety rules at all times
- Be present only in the area of the building for which they have permission
- Be cooperative and participate in all sessions and activities to the best of their ability
- Treat Parish property and that of fellow students with respect
- Clean up your work area
- No food, drink, or gum
- Cell phones, if used during Confirmation Preparation, will be taken from Candidate and returned at the end of the session.

In case of unsatisfactory conduct, the Catechist will speak with the student. If misconduct continues, the Catechist will speak to the parent(s), and the matter will be submitted to the PCL who shall contact the parents/guardians. The parent will sit with the children in class for a few weeks. If the misconduct is serious, it may be the basis for removal from the program.
